We are registered as an EBD (Emotional and Behavioural Difficulties) home and proudly welcome all children and young people, providing a supportive environment where they can feel valued, understood, and empowered to thrive.

We offer four spacious double bedrooms, each thoughtfully & collaboratively decorated to reflect the individual tastes and preferences of our young people.

The home features a large open plan living and dining area, a games room, a fully equipped kitchen, and a large bright conservatory that has been transformed into a modern gym.

We also have a calming sensory room and a quiet space that doubles as our therapy room, providing opportunities for relaxation, reflection, and emotional support.

Outside, we have a large garden with a purpose-built music studio, where young people can express themselves creatively through singing, music, and recording.

All care plans and therapeutic interventions are child-centred, tailored to meet their unique needs, strengths, and aspirations.
